

**CANTON CITY SCHOOLS
ELEMENTARY & MIDDLE SCHOOL TESTING SUMMARY
2004 - 05**

STATEWIDE TESTING

The Kindergarten Readiness test will be administered for the purpose of teacher training. The Ohio Diagnostic Screeners will be implemented in Reading, Writing and Math in grades 1 and 2; and in Writing only in grade 3. The Ohio Diagnostic Assessments will be implemented in Reading and Math in grades 1 and 2.

The Fourth Grade Proficiency Test will continue to be administered in March in Math, Citizenship and Science; and the Ohio Achievement Tests will continue to be administered in Reading in grade 3.

The Sixth Grade Proficiency test will continue to be administered in March.

The Ohio Achievement Tests will be implemented in Math in grade 3, Reading and Writing in grade 4, Reading in grade 5, Math in grade 7, and Reading and Math in grade 8.

DISTRICTWIDE TESTING

The Early Learner Assessment will continue to be administered in Kindergarten, and the Developmental Reading Assessment will continue to be administered in grades 1 and 2.

The Cognitive Abilities Test will continue to be administered in grades 2 and 5 for the identification of gifted students.

The Terra Nova will be administered in grades 2, 3, 5 and 7. Only the Reading and Math portions of the Multiple Assessment will be administered in grades 2, 3 and 5.

The "in-house" Writing assessment will continue to be administered in grades 1, 2, 3, 5, 7 and 8 as in past years.

STATEWIDE TESTING

The Ninth Grade Proficiency Test will continue to be administered in grades 11 and 12 in October and March. The special administration for grade 12 only will continue to be offered in May.

The Ohio Graduation Test will be administered in grade 10 in March.

DISTRICTWIDE TESTING

The "in-house" Writing assessment will continue to be administered in grade 9 as in past years.

The practice Ohio Graduation Test will be administered in grades 9 & 10.

The Advanced Placement tests will continue to be administered to students in those courses.

The PSAT will be administered to tenth and eleventh graders and the PLAN will be administered to tenth graders.

The CTAE Technical Assessment will continue to be administered to students in career and technical programs.
