MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
CANTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION

MONDAY, APRIL 10, 2006

The Canton City School District Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, April 10, 2006, at 7:15 p.m. at Dueber Elementary School, 815 Dueber Avenue, S.W., Canton, Ohio 44706.

Members present: James Carman, Jr., John Rinaldi, and Fred Thompson.

Absent: Nadine McIlwain and Rich Milligan

Staff members in attendance included Dianne Talarico, Tad Ellsworth, and James Reinhard.

President Thompson presided.

At this time, Mr. Thompson led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

At this time, President Thompson welcomed all people in attendance at the regularly scheduled meeting, which included Melissa Griffy, *The Repository*, Nancy Molnar, *Akron Beacon Journal*, Alan Zarek, WHBC.

At this time James Reinhard, Treasurer, informed the Board that due to unavoidable circumstances, the Minutes for the special meeting and the regularly scheduled meeting on March 27, 2006 will be approved at the April 24, 2006 Board Meeting.

At this time, Dianne Talarico, Superintendent, reported the "good things happening" in Canton City Schools:

- **Allen Elementary School** received an EETT (Enhancing Education Through Technology) Grant.
- **Belden Elementary School** thanked Northwood for their donation of classroom books.
- **Compton Elementary School** received library books with a value of \$700.00 from JP Morgan Chase.
- An update was given on the **Fairmount Elementary School's** Breakfast Reading Club.

- **Schreiber Elementary School** held mock Winter Olympics.
- **Worley Elementary School's** PTA has its own website.
- **McKinley Senior High School** students' accomplishments at the Stark County High School Art Exhibit and the *McKinley Paw Print* staff's honors were acknowledged. **McKinley** grad Kimberly Crenshaw, UCLA Law Professor, has been selected as a Fulbright Scholar. Mike Doss, also a **McKinley** graduate, plans to start a foundation to support kids in the Canton community.
- All **Passages** students completed the OGT, and Tim Henderson received a very complimentary letter from a North Canton Schools assistant principal.

WHEREAS, Fawcett Stadium requires repair work to accommodate the Hall of Fame activities for the 2006 festival and

WHEREAS, compliance with the procedures for the advertisement of bids prescribed by RC 3313.46 would delay the commencement of the needed repairs and could result in the repairs not being completed for the festival:

BE IT RESOLVED by this Board of Education, that:

Section 1. It is found and determined pursuant to RC 3313.46 that there is an urgent necessity for repair work to Fawcett Stadium.

Section 2. It is further found and determined that compliance with the procedures for the advertisements for bids prescribed by RC 3313.476 could delay commencement of the needed repairs and pose a potential threat to the completion of the work in a timely manner.

Section 3. The Business Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the necessary repairs without competitive bids.
