MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
CANTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT  
BOARD OF EDUCATION

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 2006

The Canton City School District Board of Education met for a Regular Meeting at 7:15 p.m., McKinley Senior High School, 2323 17<sup>th</sup> Street NW, Canton, Ohio.

Members present: Fred Thompson, John Rinaldi, James Carman, Jr., Nadine McIlwain, and Richard S. Milligan.

Staff members in attendance included Marva Kay Jones, Tad Ellsworth, Tim Pickana, and James Reinhard.

President Thompson presided.

At this time, Mr. Thompson led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

At this time, President Thompson welcomed all people in attendance at the regularly scheduled meeting, which included Jim Watson, O.A.P.S.E. Local 107; Jackie Leisure, O.A.P.S.E. 609; Sam Dorto, CPEA; Melissa Griffy, the Repository; and Nancy Molnar, the Akron Beacon Journal.

At this time, Marva Kay Jones, Interim Superintendent, reported the "good things happening" in Canton City Schools.

- **At Cedar Elementary** in observance of 911, the sixth grade students worked to "build up" instead of "tearing down." Mrs. Craig's and Mrs. Crone's classes went outside on Monday, Sept. 11<sup>th</sup> and worked very hard to beautify the grounds by planting flowers and spreading mulch. Other adult volunteers helped with directing and supervising. This was quite a job because many of the students had never before done any work like this. Aultman Hospital and Rice's Nursery furnished the flowers and mulch and were thanked.

Also Mrs. Hicklin's class is participating in a Service Learning Project for the 2006-07 school year. Every Friday, the class walks to St. Paul's United Methodist Church in the school's neighborhood and volunteers their time performing functional, vocational tasks. The two-hour shift is designed to foster independence outside of the classroom/school setting. The students are acquiring skills that can be generalized across settings. The project has been aligned to various ODE academic content standards and has been approved by the Canton City School District's Special

Education Department. The students have already demonstrated success and exhibit much enthusiasm.

- **McKinley High School** had 70 students that took the ACT test in Sharon, PA on Saturday, Sept. 16<sup>th</sup>. The test is not offered in Ohio until the end of October. By participating in this event, students increased their chances of receiving early college acceptance and scholarship award money. Buses left McKinley by 5:30 a.m. for the 1½-hour trip. Students did an outstanding job of preparing and participating in this opportunity.

At this time Pam Rorrer continued with “good things happening” by reporting on national recognition received by Canton City Schools Middle School Math in several publications.

Board members commended math teachers for their efforts.

At this time Mr. Reinhard introduced members of the Treasurer's office staff and thanked them for their help over the years. He also introduced members of his family and thanked them for their support. He praised the current and past Boards of Education, the administration, teachers, and support staff for making the Canton City Schools an excellent school system for his children as well as an excellent place to work. Board members and the Superintendent thanked and praised Mr. Reinhard for his work during the last 21 years and wished him a happy retirement.
