MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
CANTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION

MONDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2006

The Canton City School District Board of Education met for a Study Session at 6:30 p.m., Timken High School, 521 Tuscarawas Street West, Canton, Ohio.

Members present: Fred Thompson, John Rinaldi, James Carman, Jr., Nadine McIlwain, and Richard S. Milligan.

Staff members in attendance included Marva Kay Jones, Jim Irvin, Tad Ellsworth, and Tim Pickana.

President Thompson presided.

At this time Marva Jones, Interim Superintendent, discussed study session policies in general and Jim Irvin, Assistant Superintendent, will research the subject more and make recommendation on policy for Canton City School Study Sessions at a future date.

At this time Marva Jones, Interim Superintendent, introduced Mr. Bill Phyllis. Mr. Phyllis discussed and reviewed the Equity and Adequacy Program with the Board. A discussion on the topic followed between Mr. Phyllis and board members.

Diane Stevens Robinson, Canton City Schools Diversity Coordinator, had a slide presentation on the Timken High School Murals. The topic was diversity. A discussion regarding diversity and the Timken Murals followed the slide presentation. The topic will continue to be researched and discussed.

The Board of Education discussed creating a current vision statement for Canton City Schools.

At this time the Board stated the next regular meeting will be on November 6, 2006. The second meeting in November will be another study session on November 29, 2006 at 6:30 p.m. The location will be determined. December 11, 2006 will be a regular meeting as previously discussed at the September 25, 2006 Board of Education meeting.

The Board briefly discussed Canton City Schools policy revision. Mrs. McIlwain reviewed various policies with the Board which are currently being revised and will be presented to the Board at a future date.

At this time Mr. Rinaldi provided a handout to the Board and Administrators regarding an Industrial Technology Trades Program. The handout covered Industrial Tech Program core curriculum and goals/visions for a proposed future program in Canton City Schools.

Marva Jones provided a handout to the Board regarding procedures for new course proposals or modifications to existing courses. Marva Jones discussed the procedures in the

handout, and then the Board and Ms. Jones discussed how to proceed with the proposed course offering.
