

Remote Learners Meal Pick Up Service

In an effort to make access to meals easier for the families of Canton City students, meals will be available each day at most of the Canton City school buildings. These meals are only available for our virtual learners that are home three or five days.

Meals will be available at the following locations:

(Schools not listed are unable to service extra meals due to limited cold storage space)

Meals will be available for pick up twice daily. Once during the day and once in the evening.

- Elementary 9:00am-10:00am and 4:30pm-6:00pm
- Middle School 7:30am-8:30am and 4:30p-6:00pm
- High School 9:00am-10:00am and 4:30pm-6:00pm

Families will not be permitted to enter the building for meal pick up. Distribution areas will be building specific and identified at each building.

Students do not have to be present with an adult picking up meals. However, adults must identify which student(s) they are picking up meals for. Canton City Schools are required to confirm that students are virtual learners and eligible to receive meals.

Students will receive one breakfast and one lunch daily along with two-eight ounce servings of milk daily. Individuals may work with the Child Nutrition staff at the building level to pick up for three or five days.

If a family does not have transportation they can call 330-438-2576 to arrange for a weekly delivery of food.
