TESTING INFORMATION

NWEA MAP testing will be virtual for all students during the 20-21 school year. Beginning the week of 9/14/20, students will sign up for an available testing slot with their English and Math teachers.

Student will be taking three assessments in total - one in Math and two in English (Language and Reading). Students will be provided with multiple possible testing slots from which to choose.

Thank you in advance for your support! MAP Growth Testing helps your child's teacher identify what your child knows, what they need to learn next and the best path forward. It is an incredibly important part of developing educational experiences that best support your child's individual learning needs.

When will my child take the NWEA MAP Growth Assessment?

Students will be able to sign up for an available testing slot with their English and Math Teachers beginning the week of 9/14/2020. Blended learners will be able to sign up while they are in Math and English class. Virtual learners will be able to request a testing slot via the Math or English teacher's Google Classroom.

How will this virtual assessment work, exactly?

Prior to testing, teachers will post detailed instructions for the testing procedures including the testing session code and log-in. Please keep in mind that **MAP Growth testing is virtual this year**, so students will be physically located off-campus at a remote location on their assessment days.

Students will take one assessment per testing session, but three assessments in total - one for Math and two (Reading and Language) for English. Please consider providing your student with a testing environment that is comfortable and free of distractions on the days of their assessments. We appreciate your support!
